VARK Questionnaire for Elementary Age Learners. Have the learner choose the answer which best explains what they like. (The parent can choose to answer these questions on behalf of their younger learners, based on their observations of how their child(ren) learns.) Each answer is worth 1 point, tally up the results when done. V- Visual, A- Auditory, R- Read/Write, K- Kinesthetic. What worked for us, I read the question and asked the child to answer yes or no for each letter, up to two Yes's per question.

You can choose up to two choices in each question that best describes you.

- 1. I need to find the way to my friend's house. I would:
 - a. Use a map. (V)
